Bible Verse Games

1. Teamwork

Materials: Chalkboard, chalk, eraser, marker, scissors, extra pieces of boxboard/chipboard.

Directions:

- Write the complete verse on the chalkboard in three or four short lines and number each line.
 - 1. But grow in the grace
- 3. Lord and Savior
- 2. and knowledge of our
- 4. Jesus Christ.
- Write the numbers 1 to 4 on four separate pieces of extra boxboard, about 4x6 inches each.
- Explain the verse and then recite it with the students.
- Divide the students into three or four teams depending on the number of lines you have written.
- Give each team a number card. This becomes their team number.
- The students will all recite together the address of the verse before and after the verse.
- The teams will then recite only the words of the verse that are the same as their team number.
- After reciting the verse two or three times, take the numbers away and give all the teams a new number card. This is now their new team number.
- Now, recite the verse again with the students using the new line of their new team number.
- Continue reciting and switching team numbers until all the students have had a chance to use all the different team numbers.
- Take away all the team numbers and recite the verse together as a class.
- Have several students stand in the front and recite the verse one at a time.

Variation:

Materials: Boxboard/chipboard, marker, scissors.

- Write the complete verse on a large piece of boxboard/chipboard instead of on the chalkboard. Write it in three or four lines. Number each line just like on the chalkboard.
- Cut the verse apart so that each line is on a separate piece of boxboard/chipboard.
- Choose one student from each team to hold one line of the verse.
- Play just like the chalkboard game until all students have been on all the teams.

2. Time to Exercise

Materials: Chalkboard, chalk, eraser.

Directions:

- Write the complete verse on the chalkboard.
- Explain the verse and recite it with the students.
- Repeat the verse again and again in order for the students to learn the verse.
- Each time the verse is repeated, have the students do an exercise: jog, jump, march, hop, skip, do jumping jacks, touch your toes, twist at the hips, and so forth. This should always be done in one place. Do not let the students run around the room.
- Have several students stand in the front and recite the verse one at a time.

Variation 1:

- Choose one student to stand at the front of the room facing the other students.
- That student will choose an exercise and begin doing it.
- The other students in the class will follow the exercise the student is doing while reciting the verse.
- Repeat this until several different students have had a chance to stand at the front.

Variation 2:

- Have the students stand and find a partner.
- Tell the students to recite the verse while doing a silly exercise with their partner:
 - Hold their partner's ears, shoulders, nose, elbows, knees,...
 - Shake their partner's hands, elbows, shoulders, knees,...
- Repeat this until several different silly exercises have been done.
