
# **NEOSLetter** from Mike and Val Boado

## **Forever God is Faithful**

In 1991 God called us to Tagum City to direct the NEOS Fellowship Center. He told us in His Word that He would be "forever faithful". He will be the One caring for us and giving us all we need to bring people to Jesus Christ. It has not always been easy but it



These last two months have really pushed our "faith limit" as we take the monthly support that comes in and divide it into two sections - one section for NEOS and one section for our family. Right now, the NEOS Center is doing its best to survive its day-to-day expenses with local rentals of the basketball court, library, and weekly offerings. We then use our CTEN support to help NEOS pay the salaries of eight employees and to offset expenses that NEOS cannot cover.

Usually ministry partners send in extra gifts that help us reach our monthly budget. These past two months, however, have been difficult since we only received a total of two extra gifts. This means we have not reached our budget and that we are being stretched to trust God even more. These tough times simply remind us that God wants us to continue to trust in Him. Val will now tell you what God did for us very recently.

## A Lesson in God's Faithfulness

Recently, I e-mailed a friend about my struggle to rely on thirty people and two churches to send checks to CTEN. That next Sunday we sang "Forever God is Faithful". God spoke to me very clearly, saying, "Val, you are not relying on thirty individuals. You are relying on Me. I am the One who takes care of you. I am using others to provide for you, but I am the One who ultimately provides. So, if someone forgets to mail a check or something happens so they cannot, I will meet your needs!"

I felt awful and with tears streaming down my face I asked the Lord to forgive me. God had taught me a very important lesson. He hasn't let us down in twenty years of marriage. He has brought us through many situations in which we had no idea what we were going to do. Yet, God was always faithful. He is forever faithful.

Immediately after church that Sunday, God showed us His faithfulness in a tangible way. Mike and I had just been wondering where we were going to get enough money to buy rice. We usually put a little money aside for this each month, but for some reason, we had not done it. All we could do was put 800 pesos in an envelope and say, "Lord, we need

800 more." That same Sunday when God had given me His lesson in faithfulness, Mike and I attended a church's 53rd anniversary where Mike was invited to preach. After lunch, one of the deacons gave Mike a love gift for his preaching. When we opened the envelope, there was 1500 pesos! This was enough money for our rice plus a little bit more for a

contingency fund. God gave MORE than we asked for. His faithfulness is forever and His faithfulness is real even today.

We are still in need of

about \$6000 more to buy a new one. Pray for the rest of the needed finances to purchase it.
