## **WAITING ON GOD**

During this past year, God has taught us that when we pray, we must simply wait on Him and then be content with His answers. We know that He is in control, and so we must get to know Him through it all. We just take one day and one step at a time. Let us share with you how God has worked this past year.

We had been concerned about how we could financially put our kids into the International School in Davao, so Val applied to teach at an international school in Cebu. Over time God showed us that He now wants us to trust Him to keep our children at the International School in Davao.

Val withdrew her application to the school in Cebu and God worked it out through our supporters and the school in Davao, Faith Academy Mindanao (FAM), for us to afford to keep Esther at FAM. We just needed to wait on Him and trust Him to do it.

Valerie then applied to teach at FAM which meant that she and the kids needed a place to live in Davao. We thought we had a perfect place, and yet the owner did not want 4 people living in the apartment. We did not panic and we did not get depressed. We trusted that God had something better for us.

We recently signed a contract for an apartment with three bedrooms that is a 30-second walk from the front gate of FAM. God said NO to the first apartment because He knew He had something better for us. We just had to wait on His timing.

Valerie has been wondering what her teaching assignment would be the next school year. She just found out that she will be teaching second grade at FAM for the 2011-2012 school year.

Valerie has been dreaming about taking a trip through Asia to visit missionary friends for many years now. In January, God stopped saying, "Wait." and finally said, "Yes". Val flew DeeAnn to Korea to live with some friends for three months. After being with Dee for two weeks, she went to China and then to Nepal. It was a wonderful trip that has helped her both spiritually and physically. She is now able to tolerate walking for exercise and is now exercising on a regular basis.

Valerie has also been trying to book our flights to the USA. It has taken her over one month since each quote she got was just too expensive. We prayed and asked God to give us flights that would be the best for us. We finally booked flights that have

saved us nearly \$3000. God has been so good as we have waited on him for these many things. We chose to take one day and one step at a time.

## **FAMILY NEWS**

DeeAnn was given a wonderful opportunity to live with an American family in Korea from January to April of 2011. The father is a marketing professor in one of the oldest universities in Seoul. DeeAnn was able to learn the basics of the Korean language and though she left home a "little girl", she returned to the Philippines a responsible young woman. What an awesome gift this trip was for her. She will never



forget it. Thank you, Robert, Crystal, Robby, Christopher, and Daniel.

We will be enrolling all three kids at FAM this August. Esther and Steven will be in high school and DeeAnn will be in middle school. Valerie and the kids will live in an apartment (just a cross the street from the school) in Davao City during the week and travel to Tagum on the weekends.

The wonderful thing about the apartment is that is has its own refrigerator and air conditioner so we don't have to buy those items. God is good.

Valerie will be teaching second grade this next school year at FAM. She is excited about this new ministry assignment and is looking forward to living with the kids in Davao City. Mike will stay in Tagum and continue to oversee the NEOS Fellowship Center.

Please pray for our finances. We will be paying rent and utilities on this apartment and tuition for three students, as well as the cost of traveling back and forth each week to Davao City. We know that this is what God has for our family for the next few years and we trust Him to take care of us during these changes in our lives and ministry. We are choosing to take one day and one step at a time.

We will be in the USA from May to July of this year. We will land in Indianapolis on May 28 and fly out of Indianapolis on July 19. Here is our tentative schedule so far:

Please also pray about how God would have you be apart of our trip to the USA. It is amazing how expensive the flights are now, and yet we know that we need to take this trip. We know that God is going to provide for our every need. From the cost of our plane tickets, to Valerie's teaching license, to gasoline and hotels and just day-by-day needs. God is in control and we will just take the summer one day and one step at a time. Thank you for praying for us.

#### **NEOS NEWS**

We want you to praise the Lord with us that the old blue car that belonged to NEOS finally sold this past January. We were able to use the money from the sale of the blue car to add to our balance of what we owed for the purchase of the Kia in October. God in His goodness has helped us pay off the balance of the Kia. Thank you to all of you who helped with that project. We are grateful.



The NEOS livelihood program continues to bless lives each day. We continue to provide homes and jobs for people, and their hearts are being softened to the Gospel. Right now we have three homes and five pedicabs (motorcycles with a sidecar) running daily. We would like to purchase another pedicab so that one more family can be involved in this wonderful project.

The goal is for the pedicabs to grow in number so that the income for the pedicabs can be put into the general fund at NEOS. As the number of pedicabs grows, the income for NEOS will also grow. We hope to eventually get NEOS to the point of being completely supported by indigenous funds.

We continue to ask God for the empty lot that is right next to NEOS. Even though the owner has no desire to talk to us about selling, the Lord has given

us signs that He is working. An anonymous donor has a great burden for this empty lot and wants to help us make it a reality. This donor will match any designated donation for the empty lot with the exact same amount for up to \$40,000.

The price of the empty lot as of the moment is \$60,000. Please pray that the owner will be willing to talk to us about selling the land and also come down on the price. Please pray that the money needed to purchase the land will be acquired.

Please pray that God will move and the owner will soften her heart so that she will come to know Him through this situation. Please write "empty lot" on the memo line of your donation so that it can be added to the matching project. Thank you very much.

Our annual NEOS Vacation Bible School was held during the last week of April. The theme was <u>The Ten Commandments</u>. The exciting part of this VBS was the main Bible teachers. He has been with me every step of the way and He has just wanted me to trust in Him about my future. He wants me to completely surrender my life to Him and allow Him to work.

I feel like God was trying to show me and teach me to rely on Him. He is my Father, the One I should run to in times of need. He is always there. He is here for me when I am all by myself. He promised to never leave me, and to always be with me, no matter what.
